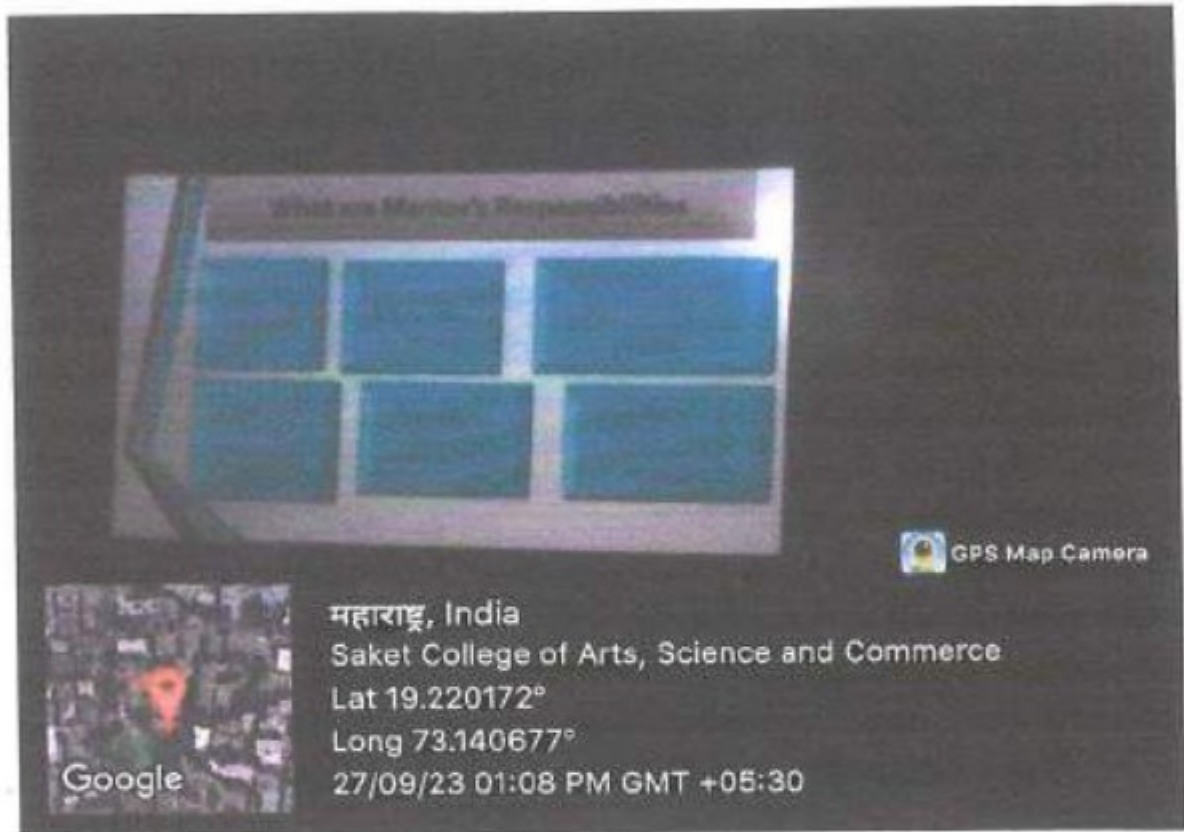
Outcomes:

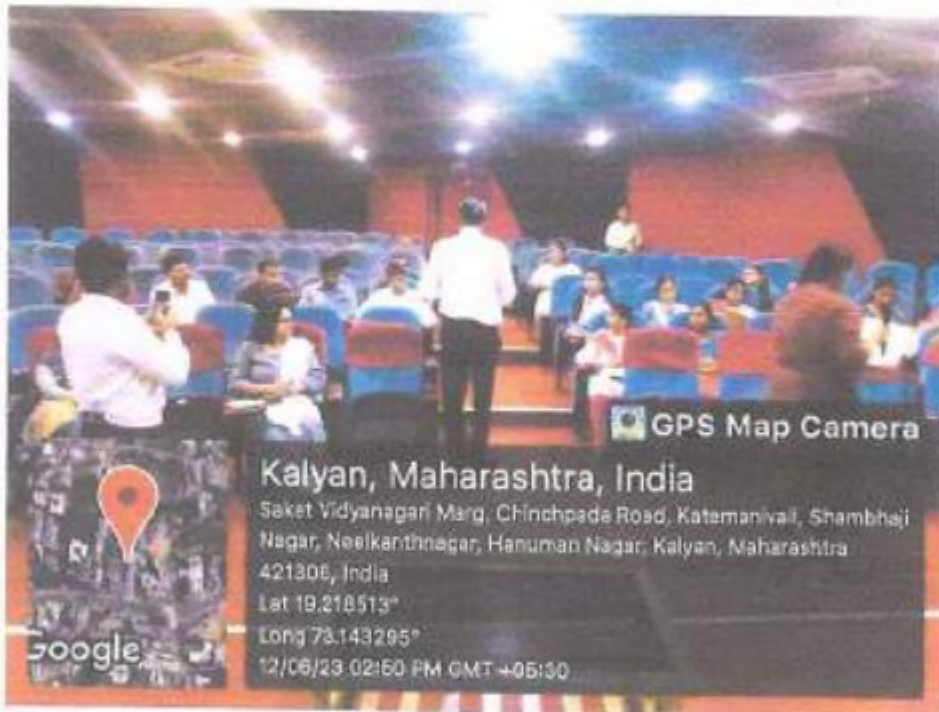
Outcomes:
