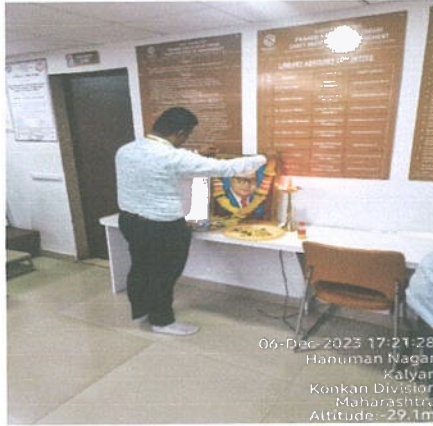
### Mahaparinirvan Diwas Report.

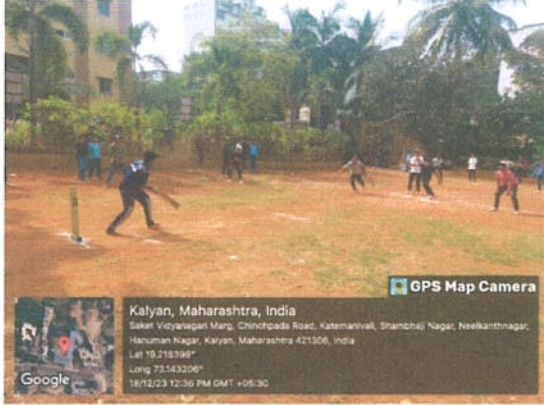
